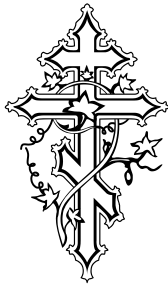

On May 16, Karen and I attended the Bishop's Tea which was held at St. John's Cathedral Hall.

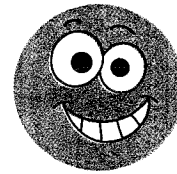

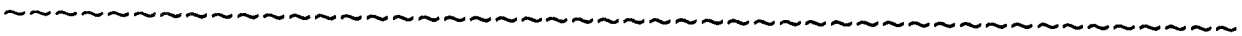
